**Invitation for Bids (IFB) for  
Rescue Team Essential Equipment**

1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in Development Business, issue no. 51 of 25 December 2010.
2. The Government of People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association toward the cost of Emergency 2007 Cyclone Recovery and Restoration Project (ECRRP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the Contract for **Rescue Team Essential Equipment**.
3. The Disaster Management Bureau now invites sealed bid from eligible and qualified bidders for Supply of *Rescue Team Essential Equipment necessary for disaster search and rescue operation*. (Details in the Tender Documents).
4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Guidelines.

Tenderer/Manufacturers should have a minimum 5 years of overall experience in the supply of same types of goods/equipment and related services and also a minimum 3 years of specific experience in the supply of similar goods and related services as specified in the BDS. Tenderer/Manufacturers should have average annual turnover in converted US dollars, defined as the total payments received for contracts completed or to be received for contracts under execution by the bidder for the last 03 (three) years and availability of minimum liquid assets or net working capital or credit facilities in USD or equivalent from a Bank for each lot as mentioned below:  
Average Annual Turnover Lot 1 – US\$ 0.4 million, for Lot 2 – US\$ 0.2 million, for Lot 3 – US\$ 0.2 million and, for Lot 3 – US\$ 0.1 million. Bidder, participating in multiple lots must comply with the cumulative requirement for the lots it is participating.-  
Availability of liquid assets or net working capital or credit facilities for Lot 1 – US\$ 0.2 million, for Lot 2 – US\$ 0.1 million, for Lot 3 – US\$ 0.1 million and, for Lot 3 – US\$ 0.05 million. Bidder, participating in multiple lots must comply with the cumulative requirement for the lots it is participating.

A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee **US\$ 15 or BDT.1000/-per document for each Package** on or before 06 February 2011 during office hour. The method of payment will be in cash. The Bidding Documents will be provided hand to hand.
8. Bid Clarification Meeting will be held on **15 January 2011 at 2:00 pm** at the address given below.
9. Bids are to be submitted to the address below at or before **2:00 pm Bangladesh time on 10 February 2011**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who like to attend physically at the address [below] **at 2:30 pm Bangladesh time on 10 February 2011**. Each bid should be accompanied by "Bid Security". The amount is; for **Lot-1: US \$. 5,000**, **Lot-2: US \$. 2,500**, **Lot-3: US \$. 3,000** and **Lot-4: US \$. 1,000** or an equivalent amount for each lot in a freely convertible currency.
